

Mastering L-PRF® in Your Clinical Practice

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed for clinicians who are interested in enhancing their bone and soft tissue grafting techniques for dental implant cases. Leukocyte- and Platelet-Rich Fibrin (L-PRF®) is derived from a small sample of the patient's blood, taken at the point of care and processed to develop a fibrin clot. The fibrin clot is prepared into a membrane that is rich in platelets, growth factors and cytokines necessary to produce rapid healing and efficient regeneration.

This biomaterial is resilient, strong and pliable, making it easy to manipulate and receptive to suturing. It can be cut to size and is supple enough to adapt to many anatomical areas. It is adhesive in nature, making it an ideal carrier for bone graft material. Uses include: bulking graft material, replacing graft material, using it as a barrier membrane, placing it in extraction sites for increased healing, and using it in guided tissue regeneration procedures. It is also ideal for extraction/immediate implant cases.

Research clearly indicates that L-PRF significantly enhances wound healing in both hard and soft tissue. In this course, you will learn the science behind L-PRF and how to incorporate it in your clinical practice. The hands-on training will demonstrate the blood draw, teach you how to create the L-PRF membrane/plugs, and give attendees experience with membrane handling characteristics.



Dr. Nathan Doyel

Dr. Nathan Doyel graduated from OHSU dental school in 1997 with honors. He has been honored as a "Top Dentist" in Oregon for many years and is the founder of Deserving Smile, a not-for-profit organization dedicated to reconstructing entire smiles for deserving individuals. He has been an innovator with the "Trial Smile", a technique developed for full mouth reconstruction to ensure ideal results.

Dr. Doyel is an Associate Fellow with the AAID and is a leader in 3D CAD/CAM dentistry. He enjoys mentoring other dentists and sharing his knowledge with them. In order to facilitate dental education, he is the founder of Dental Surgical Camps and hosts several camps throughout the year. Dr. Doyel has advanced training in dental implants and related procedures including sinus lifts, bone augmentation, bone expansion, and guided surgery. He was recently designated as a Diplomate of ABOI/ID which symbolizes the highest level of competence in implant dentistry.
